Paul's Life After Acts

Paul spent two years in Rome as a prisoner and preached the gospel without hindrance (*Eccl. Hist.* 2.22; cf. Acts 28:30). He wrote 2 Timothy from Rome and described what happened and what awaited him (Ibid.; cf. 2 Tim. 4:16–18). Paul knew he was about to be martyred for the faith (2 Tim. 4:6).

Luke concluded Acts at Paul's first trial before the Jews because he may not have been allowed to be with him in his first Roman trial (2 Tim. 4:16). However, only Luke was with Paul in the end (2 Tim. 4:11). As Nero became more depraved he lashed out at the Christians in Rome. Eusebius (church historian) writes this:

It is recorded that in [Nero's] reign that Paul was beheaded in Rome itself. (*Eccl. Hist.* 2.25)

The dating of Paul's death would have to be around AD. 64–65, because that's when the persecution of Christians began and around the time that Nero set fire to Rome and blamed them as his scapegoats (Tacitus *Annals* 15.44.3–8; Suetonius *Nero* 16.2).

This timeline has proven to be problematic for scholars. Still, explanations have been given to reconcile the data —one of which is that Paul was released after the two years imprisonment mentioned in Acts and was later imprisoned for preaching and then beheaded.

Because of jealousy and strife Paul showed the way to the prize for patient endurance. After he had been seven times in chains, had been driven into exile, had been stoned, and had preached in the east and in the west, he won the genuine glory for his faith, having taught righteousness to the whole world and having reached the farthest limits of the west. Finally, when he had given his testimony before the rulers, he thus departed from the world and went to the holy place, having become an outstanding example of patient endurance. (*1 Clement* 5.5–7)

You are the highway of those who are being killed for God's sake; you are fellow initiates of Paul, who was sanctified, who was approved, who is deservedly blessed—may I be found in his footsteps when I reach God!— who in every letter remembers who in Christ Jesus. (Ignatius *Eph.* 12.2)

During a recent Sunday morning service, we sang "**O Sacred Head Now Wounded**," one of the oldest Christian hymns still in use. During John Gore's offering meditation, reference was made to a line in one of Dottie Rambo's songs, "**Remind Me Dear Lord**."

The contrast between these two songs could not be more apparent due, largely to the totally different styles as well as to the more than eight centuries between the writing of both. They each cast a different light on age-old Biblical truths and each song appeals to a different 21st century audience.

Born in 1934, Joyce Reba Luttrell (Dottie Rambo) wrote more than 2500 gospel songs, largely in the gospel/country genre before her untimely death in a bus crass in 2008. "*Different strokes for different folks*"
