When You're in A Position of Leadership

Robert Irvine is a restaurateur and chef who's the star of a show called Restaurant Impossible. He began with the Royal Navy and served aboard the Royal Yacht *Britannia*. He takes his skills, goes to failing diners, and helps them turn around. It's not without its problems, though. Sometimes, the main issue is the people he has to deal with: the owners, employees, and managers. Their mindset and attitudes are often the problems. He works with them and sometimes remodels and reworks the operation. Usually, by the end, with the cooperation of the folks, he's turned things around.

Titus was the kind of guy who was good at working through problems. He'd traveled with Paul and encountered problems and knew how to navigate them, and he was sometimes sent by Paul (Gal. 2:1-5; 2 Cor. 7:5-7, 13-15; 8:16-17, 22-24). He's in Crete when Paul writes to him (Titus 1:5), and there are some things we need to know about this place:

1. It was the birthplace of Zeus, a god who often lied and raped women. Cretans were also known to be liars (1:12). Titus was going to preach the God who never lies (1:2).
2. When he was there, mercenaries lived there and were notorious for violence and sexual corruption. Because it's an island, several ports occupied various points. Wherever there are men at sea for periods, there will be brothels nearby.

Titus was to commission good leaders (1:5-9). Your character matters to be a good leader—this is the basis of how Titus was to have selected elders. In addition to this, you can't care about being famous; you must keep an open mind, you have to serve those you've been placed over, you have to do more than you expect of others, you have to listen well and communicate clearly.

The boss drives his men; the leader coaches them. The boss depends upon authority, the leader on goodwill. The boss inspires fear; the leader inspires enthusiasm. The boss says, "I," and the leader says, "We." The boss fixes the blame for the breakdown; the leader fixes the breakdown. The boss knows how it is done; the leader shows how. The boss says, "Go;" the leader says, "Let's go!"—H. Gordon Selfridge

Willie's Pronouns

Occasionally, the question may arise as to the modern use of such words as thee, thy, thou, thine and similar "archaic" terms in worship, particularly in many of the hymns which we still sing.

Thee, thy, thou and thine are termed "Shakespearean pronouns" and, in Shakespeare's time, were usually used only by the upper classes and in a Biblical or worship context. Old Willie lived from 1564-1616 and the King James Bible first appeared in 1611. All of this fits together nicely to help explain why both the KJV as well as untold numbers of poems, hymns and other literature of that period are sprinkled with such pronouns of devotion.

Generations of worshippers have learned thousands of hymns and gospel songs which include these words and, attempting to "modernize" them just doesn't ring true. After all, "I Am Yours, O Lord," sounds a bit hollow!!!
